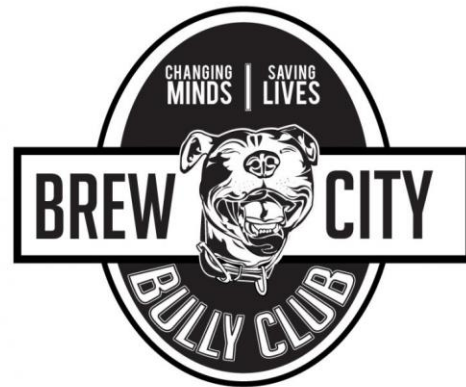


Brew City Bully Club Rescue & Adoption Program



The BCBC wants to build long lasting relationships with our adopters. When you adopt from the BCBC, you are becoming part of a family! You'll be invited to attend various events, outreach booths, parades, and other opportunities with your Breed Ambassador to help Change Minds and Save Lives!

Adoption Information and Requirements

- (1) Owner is at least 21 years of age – or you better be a rock solid dog owner, impress us!
- (2) Must own home or have landlord approval – we will check!
- (3) Must live within 1 hour of the Milwaukee, WI area (Please email adopt@brewcitybullies.org with any questions)
- (4) Provide solid references - good references include veterinarians, dog walkers, dog daycare managers or someone with dog experience.
- (5) Demonstrate that you have a clear understanding of the challenges of this breed and how you will handle them.
- (6) Agree to our Foster to Adopt process and Home Visit with all household members present.
- (7) Sign a legally binding adoption contract and make a \$200 donation to the BCBC.

BCBC Foster to Adopt Process

Because we want to make sure we've found the right home for our dogs, we've established a Foster to Adopt process. The dog would be in your home during this transition time, however would still be property of the BCBC. We would like to check from time to time to see how the dog is adjusting and how training is coming along. You will need to sign a Foster to Adopt Contract, follow our training procedures and keep us updated on the dog. Once the dog is responding well to your family and pets, the dog's training is coming along and everyone is comfortable with the match, we would schedule a time to come to your home and finalize the adoption!

Your newly adopted dog...

Once everything is finalized, your new family member will come with:

- (1) Full vetting; Rabies, Distemper Shot, Heartworm test, Microchip, and will be spayed/neutered.
- (2) Some knowledge of basic training; sit, stay, down, off, etc.
- (3) Collar, rabies and microchip tag
- (4) Free lifetime training for dogs that are adopted within one-hour's drive of the Milwaukee, WI area.
- (5) Most importantly, lots of love, hugs and kisses to give to you and your family!

** The BCBC wholeheartedly believes in Positive Reinforcement Training. We hope that your training philosophies align with ours - or that you are open to learning more! It's very important to us that our adopters don't use any punitive training methods on our dogs.
